

Local Attractions

Charminar

Hyderabad is almost synonymous with the Charminar. This architectural monument, which is a part of the Old City with Palaces and traditional Bazaars around it, was built by Mohammed Quli Qutub Shah, the founder of Hyderabad, in 1591 at the centre of the original city layout.

Qutub Shahi Tombs

The tombs of the legendary Qutub Shahi kings are within the Golconda Fort. These tombs are said to be the oldest historical monuments in Hyderabad. The uniqueness of the tombs lies in the fact that they are the only tombs in the world where an entire dynasty has been buried at one place.

Mecca Masjid

Mecca Masjid is located at a stone's throw from the Charminar. The Masjid is so named because the building blocks were brought from Mecca to build the central arch. The Qutub Shahi Kings started building the mosque, which was later completed by Aurangzeb in 1694.

Salarjung Museum

This museum houses one of the largest personal collections of antiques by one man - Mir Yousuf Ali Khan, Salar Jung III. The collection includes Persian carpets, Mughal miniatures, Chinese porcelain, Japanese lacquer ware, European sculpture like the Veiled Rebecca, Ancient manuscripts and many other fabulous items.

Golconda Fort

Golconda is one of the most famous forts of India. The name comes from the Telugu words 'Golla Konda' meaning 'Shepherd's Hill'. Golconda was originally a mud fort, which was rebuilt by the first three Qutub Shahi kings over a period of 62 years. The fort is well known for its acoustics. The exclusive Sound & Light Show at the Golconda Fort takes you right back in time.

Ramoji Film City

Ramoji Film City (RFC) is the world's largest integrated film studio complex spread over 2,000 acres. It houses some of the world's most sophisticated film equipment and breathtaking sets, along with natural and artificial attractions. Tourists and the film fraternity have access to these facilities and 3-star & 5-star hotel accommodation.



Shopping

Shopping in Hyderabad is a unique experience. The bazaars, with a mix of ancient, medieval and modern characters, have endless items to offer. The city offers everything from antiques to handicrafts to jewelry, from dresses to leather goods to pearls and semi-precious stones.

Hyderabadi Pearls and Bangles

Pearls from all over the world are said to come to Hyderabad, because the artisans here are skilled in piercing and stringing pearls without damaging them.

Zardozi Embroidery Work

A specialty of Hyderabad is zardozi (Silk thread and cord) embroidery work. There is an amazing collection of embroidered sarees, Lacchas (Long tops paired with long skirts and dupatta), ghagra and cholis (skirt and blouse), salwar kameez and even sandals with embroidery work.

Hyderabadi Sarees

Hyderabad has sarees to please every woman in the world. Ikkat saris are the famous ones that are locally woven. However handloom sarees from all over the country are available in abundance locally.

Bidri Artworks

BIDRI - a specialized metal handicraft where silver inlay work is done on a black metal alloy of zinc & copper.


