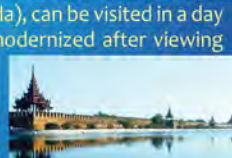
The World’s Wonder Golden Rock (Kyikhtiyo Pagoda), can be visited in a day return trip and you will be modernized after viewing this Pagoda.

- Submitters can submit up to 3 abstracts
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official Congress publications.
- Presenting authors of abstracts must be registered participants.
- Please note: Registration fees must be received by the Secretariat **by 15 August, 2017**, to ensure inclusion of the abstract in the Congress publications and in order to be scheduled for presentation.
- Academic Paper submitters must have privileges to be regarded as early bird registrator.

ABSTRACT PREPARATION

Before you begin, please prepare the following information:

- Presenting author’s and Co-authors’ details
- Full first and family name(s).

- Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country, email address
- Abstract title – limited to 25 words in UPPER CASE
- Abstract text – limited to 300 words, including acknowledgements. We recommend using word-processing software (for example, Word) for editing your abstract and counting the number of words.
- Abstracts should clearly state:

 - Material and Method:
 - Result(s):
 - Conclusion:
- Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.
- Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as numerals.
- Abstract Topics– abstracts must be allocated to a specific category for the Scientific Program. You will need to select the category most suited to your abstract.
- Tables – A maximum of 3 tables of up to 10 rows x 10 columns can be included per abstract.
- Graphs and Images – A maximum of 2 images can be included per abstract. The maximum file size of each graph/image is 500 KB. The maximum pixel size of the graph/image is 600(w) x 800(h) pixel. Graphs and images may be uploaded in JPG, PNG and GIF format only. When including a table, it is recommended to save the table as an image and then upload it in to the abstract.
- After you submit your abstract, you can re-enter the submission link at any time to view and edit your abstract until the deadline date.
